	Permit Authorizing Individual LIST: (<u>Designated</u> <u>PAIs</u>)	Assess work site for combustibles, hazards, controls. Verify fire protection and extinguishing equipment is available. Fill out <u>Hot Work Permit</u> and provide to Permit Owner. Review requirements with Permit Owner. Close permit when done. Maintain a <u>Hot Work Log</u> .			
	Third Party Reviewer Hot Work	 Provides additional PAI oversight to activities or areas identified as <u>High Risk Hot Work Areas & Tasks</u>. Hot work identified as high risk requires documented work planning. Obtain permit before performing ANY hot work

	Long Term Hot Work	For frequent welding/burning brazing operations. Locations inspected monthly by department responsible for the area. No requirement for notification of start & stop of Hot Work Reference: Long Term Hot Work Permitting Process, Designated Locations, and Permit Current Designated safe locations: Ross Maintenance Shop Yates Hoist Maintenance Shop (the old Battery Shop) Foundry Shop Water Treatment Plant Shop
