- Outlines the procedures, instructions, reports, and personnel used in the implementation of the service providers QA/QC System for work being performed.
- The Contractor shall maintain an adequate inspection system and perform such inspections as will ensure that the work called for by the contract conforms to contract requirements and any subsidiary drawings, specifications, and requirements (e.g. pre cleaning specifications, blasting specifications, blast media specifications, primer specification, paint specifications).
- Project requires a Certificate of Conformance
 - o A certificate of conformance is a signed document issued by a relevant authority that validates that certain and/or described specifications exist in a given product or service. It is an official recognition that a product and or service possesses the technical specifications alleged by the manufacturer, provider or seller.

SDSTA will perform a quality assurance review of all contractor work (Including the service providers QC Plan) to ensure that proper criteria, regulations, laws, codes, principles and professional procedures will be used. SDSTA will review the work of the contractor during each phase of the project (If applicable) and upon project completion to assess adherence to the QC Plan and appropriate objectives.
